## Terms and Conditions

### 1. Fees

Fees are not refundable under any circumstances.

### 2. Child Behaviour, Parent Support & Discipline.

At Cascade all children have a right to feel safe and happy. Where children are behaving in a continuously disruptive, threatening or violent manner they will be disciplined by the time out method and the parents will be notified. Should the child's behaviour not improve the parents will be requested to intervene in an appropriate manner as advised by Cascade to ensure consistency in home and Cascade discipline methods. Should the child continue having behavioural problems and Cascade feel that it is having a detrimental effect on the other children the parent will be asked to remove their child.

### 3. Child Absences

Cascade should be notified if your child is to be absent from the Club for a vacation or due to illness.

### 4. Vaccinations

All children attending Cascade are requested to have all vaccinations as per the requirements of the Ministry of Public Health in Kuwait. A copy of the vaccination list can be obtained upon request. The Ministry of Public Health have the right to inspect and test children only with your approval. However failure to maintain the vaccinations as required by the Ministry of Public Health in Kuwait will render your child's place at Cascade forfeit.

### 5. School Vacations

As Cascade practises the British curriculum for nursery schools we try to maintain a vacation plan consistent with UK dates. However in some cases vacations are compulsory as per the Ministry of Islamic Affairs. These days may fall out with planned dates and Cascade will not be held liable for any situation arising for unplanned vacations.

### 6. Medical Emergencies

In the event of any situation where a child requires emergency medical treatment, Cascade will endeavour to contact the parents through the numbers supplied in this form. Cascade will also use their best judgement to contact the emergency services where appropriate. Where parents cannot be contacted within an appropriate time frame based on the medical emergency, the parent, by signing this form consent to allow the medical officer in charge to give all treatment deemed necessary by that medical officer. The parent by signing this form also affirms that all allergies and medical conditions that their child is known to have are written in the special needs section of this form.

### 7. Child Clothing and Belongings

Any and all clothing and belongings of a child attending Cascade should be effectively and permanently labelled by the parents. Cascade will accept no liability for the damage or loss of any items that are not labelled.

### 8. Photographs

Cascade has the right to take photographs of the children in attendance at Cascade. The photographs are used in evidence of our practices for the Ministry of Social Affairs. The photographs will also be used for marketing materials to advertise the Club and can be used after your child has been withdrawn from Cascade. Cascade will not publish names or inappropriate photographs. Cascade will also endeavour to give the parents copies of child photographs on at least an annual basis.

### 9. Excursions

Cascade occasionally take the children out on excursions during Nursery hours. Examples of outings are local parks, swing parks, shops, museums, etc, where there are places of interest for the children. During these excursions Cascade accepts no liability for children when they are participating in activities which are led by other organisations e.g. horse riding, water sports. All individual excursions will be notified to the parents and consent must be obtained by Cascade.
